

CHILDREN'S LAWNMOWER PULL RULES
DEERFIELD VALLEY FARMERS' DAY FAIR AUGUST 11, 2017

1. Any non sportsman conduct will not be tolerated and in automatic disqualification
2. Registration fee is \$10.00 per tractor. Only one pit crew member per tractor is allowed in the pit area. Wristbands will be issued. No more than one child per pull. All members must be present at the time of check-in. No child under the age of 5 will be permitted to pull. No child over the age of 17 will be permitted to pull. No refunds.
3. There will be 4 classes 900 lbs class-strictly stock tractors can weigh up to 900 lbs, 1100 lbs class, 1200 lbs class and 1500 lbs class.
4. No 4 wheel drive tractors allowed
5. Helmets, shirts, shoes are required. Open toe shoes will not be permitted. No exceptions!!!!
6. Inspection of mowers will take place the day of the tractor pull. Wheelie bars are not required on the 900 strictly stock class. There must be a wheelie Bar on tractor/lawnmower for all other classes. Wheelie bar will be inspected at time of entry. Wheelie bar will need to hold up tractor. The tractors front end can not raise over 18" in height. No training wheels will be permitted. A strictly stock tractor must remain stock from factory, stock tires, stock muffler etc.
7. Mowing deck must be removed for safety reasons
8. Governor may be adjusted maximum of 25hp or less. Modification to exhaust is allowed on all other classes. You can use two motors on a lawn mower, but can not exceed 25 hp.
9. Tires can be filled chains are not allowed. Weights and anything attached to the tractor must be properly secured. If objects are not properly secured they will have to be removed. No use of weights as a seat or be on the seat. Nothing strapped to the hood. Child must remain seated on seat on tractor.
10. All pull hitches can be made but they must have a height of 12 inches or less and must be solid to hold and pull. A 2" ring is required for hitch.
11. Pull will be 25 feet. The stone boat can weigh as much as 3000 lbs.
12. CHILD'S ARMS MUST BE IN AIR AND FEET CLEAR FROM PEDAL WHEN AT STARTING LINE. CHILD CAN NOT STAND ON TRACTOR WHEN IN MIDDLE OF PULL. CHILD MUST REMAIN SEATED ON THE SEAT AT ALL TIMES DURING THE PULL. IF CHILD STANDS AT ANYTIME WHILE PULLING CHILD WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
13. Parent can help the child put tractor in gear and back up to the stone boat. They may not help the child run the tractor during the pull. Once the tractor is hooked to the boat the parent may not touch the tractor unless an emergency arises. If tractor is touched by parent child will be disqualified.
14. If you have time please spend some time with child on tractor practicing backing up and stopping to have a safe pull.
15. Track Marshall word is final.
16. Pulling rain or shine
